The calf market remains very strong. Questions are starting to arise about the sustainability of this market at current levels. Cattle imports from Mexico have been suspended since late November but that could be lifted very soon. Depending on what kind of quota is established and lack of any tariffs on agriculture products would certainly affect the shortage of livestock available for buyers. We could see a price adjustment as this happens so you might want to think about marketing your cattle now.
